God's Inspired Word

Paul the Apostle taught his young friend and son in the faith many things about serving God and about God's Word. In Paul's second letter to Timothy, he wrote:

"All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man [or woman] of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work." (2 Timothy 3:16, words in brackets added)

"Inspired" in this verse means "God breathed," making the meaning different from our common use of the word which usually refers to exceptional creativity. God, by His Holy Spirit, is the author of Scripture, breathing upon the writers. It was *given* by the Holy Spirit. Thus it is God's Word. No other book can truly make that claim.
