



Jesus--"The Word of God"

The Apostle John wrote of Jesus--"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God" (John 1:1, 2). In the Book of Revelation John wrote: ". . . and His name is called The Word of God" (Revelation 19:13).

Jesus not only spoke and taught the Word of God, He also is the Word of God. One aspect this name reveals about Jesus is His exaltedness. We may speak and teach God's Word, but Jesus IS God's Word.

Kings and queens rule by decree or declaration. They speak and their decrees become law or set things in motion for their kingdom. Jesus--as the most exalted King of Kings and Lord of Lords--rules all the nations by His Word. John wrote: ". . . out of His mouth goes a sharp sword" (Revelation 19:15).

So we see our exalted Lord Jesus was present in the beginning as the Word when all things were created and He will rule in the forever future as the Word of God.
