Speaking the Promises

When memorizing Scripture, we use verbal repetition as a means to help us learn. Speaking God's promises aloud can also have spiritual benefit for us. Consider the following benefits. Some may be automatic, but our intentional awareness and agreement increase the benefits:

Speaking God's promises:

- Declares that God is our source.
- 2. Reminds us of God's good heart and good will toward us in that He promises to provide our needs (see Psalm 25:8, 9).
- 3. Builds our faith to receive the promise--since faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God (see Romans 10:17).
- 4. Delivers a blow to doubt, fear and unbelief.
- 5. Aligns our thoughts with the truth and God's Kingdom principles.
