6. Joins our faith with God's Word. And "faith is the substance [foundation] of things hoped for" (Hebrews 11:1).

When we speak God's Word aloud, as we His ambassadors on earth are privileged to do, God's power is released. *Proclaim* is a little stronger word than *speak*, and it historically referred most often to the official function of a herald who announced in the city square the proclamations of the ruling monarch. The herald spoke for the monarch. Every child of God has the privilege to proclaim God's Word. We can *proclaim* God's promises aloud in the privacy of our home or car. It doesn't have to be loud--just intentional and in faith. When we proclaim God's Word, we send forth the power of God's Word to rule on earth by decreeing God's will into the spiritual and natural realms, remembering this power is not of us but of God's Word.
