Ask . . . Seek . . . Knock

When you find a promise in God's Word that you need, you can be sure you will receive it if you seek it. That's the meaning of Luke 11:9 which says, ". . . ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you." We are to persist and continue to believe for the promises. While God hears you when you first ask and begins to work to bring the answer to you, your continued seeking in faith helps us grow spiritually. Also--some of our requests and some of God's promises will take time for God to work out. He works behind the scenes, sometimes for a long time, and we usually cannot see much, if anything, of what He is doing.

Remember, all God's promises to His children belong to us, but it is "though faith and patience" (persistence) that we inherit the promises.
