**Matthew 14:27** “But immediately Jesus spoke to them, saying, ‘Be of good cheer! It is I; do not be afraid.’ ”

**Psalms 34:4 NKJ** “I sought the Lord, and He heard me and delivered me from all my fears.”

**Psalms 23:4** “Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.”

**2 Kings 6:16** “So he [Elisha] answered, ‘Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them.’ ”

**2 Chronicles 20:15, 17** “And he said, ‘Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the Lord to you: “Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s . . . . You will not need to fight in this battle. Position yourselves, stand still and see the salvation of the Lord, who is with you, O Judah and Jerusalem!” Do not fear or be dismayed, tomorrow go out against them, for the Lord is with you.’ ”

**Deuteronomy 31:6** “Be strong and of good courage, do not fear nor be afraid of them, for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you.”

**Psalms 27:1** “The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? The Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?”

**Isaiah 41:10** “ ‘Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.’ ”

**Isaiah 43:1** “But now, thus says the Lord, who created you, O Jacob, and He who formed you, O Israel, ‘Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Mine.’ ”

**Isaiah 51:7** “ ‘Listen to Me, you who know righteousness, you people in whose heart is My law: Do not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their insults.’ ”

**Romans 8:15** “For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, ‘Abba, Father.’ ”
